Cart Lease Club and Trail Fee (the use of a Privately-Owned Cart) is available to Full Members Only

- **Trail Fee Family** (Unlimited) is billed semi-annually at \$962.50 for an annual fee of \$1,925.00.
- **Trail Fee Single** (Unlimited) is billed semi-annually at \$687.50 for an annual fee of \$1,375.00.
- **Daily Trail Fee** (Per Round) Usage fee for 18-holes billed daily is currently at \$14.00.
- **Club Cart Lease Plan** is billed quarterly at \$343.75 for an annual fee of \$1,375.00 (Plus Tax).
- **Club Cart Rental Fee** Usage fee for 18-holes is currently at \$25.00 (Including Tax).
- **Daily Trolley Fee** (Per Round) Usage fee for 18-holes is currently at \$9.50 (Including Tax).
- **Trolley Lease Plan** (Unlimited) is billed annually at \$650 (Including Tax).

Club Members may use a privately-owned cart on the Azalea and or Challenge courses as a courtesy (cart fees need to be paid). All privately-owned carts to be used must be registered with the Club.

Monthly Dues: (Non-Resident) **\$201.54**

This membership entitles the Member, and eligible family members, to use the Club facilities, including the 3-hole Challenge golf course, tennis, pickleball, swimming and clubhouse without payment of usage fees.

The membership includes a limited number of rounds on the Holly and Magnolia golf courses with the payment of a reduced green fee. The Azalea golf course can be enjoyed on an unlimited basis with the payment of a reduced green fee.

***Club Memberships may be upgraded to a "higher" category of membership, provided that the applicable Transfer Fee paid is commensurate to the category of membership to which the "upgrade" is applied.

Lifestyle Membership

Monthly Dues: **\$174.05**

This membership entitles the Member, and eligible family members, to use the Club facilities, including the tennis, pickleball, swimming and clubhouse without payment of usage fees.

Lifestyle Members are only entitled to golf as a registered guest of a Member.

Swimming Pool

The renovated "saltwater" Pool is available to ALL members, and their accompanied guests, at NO Cost.

The (3-hole) Challenge Course is available to ALL members of Pinewild, and their accompanied guests, at NO Cost, including complimentary cart usage when available.

Full Member Range Program

Full Members will receive unlimited range balls, non-transferrable. One fob per member permitted. Member's fob will be replenished in increments of 50-baskets per refill.

Full Member Options to use their Privately-Owned Cart

Full Members of the Club may participate in several different options, whereby a member can utilize a privately-owned cart on the golf courses. These options for Full Members include per round usage or an annual fee for unlimited usage.

Reciprocity Program available to Full Members

Reciprocal Play at over a dozen other courses in the region. Over the past several years, Pinewild has nurtured great relationships with numerous Clubs in the region. Several of these Clubs are private, and all present a great opportunity for all of our members to travel and play a course in Cary, Lexington, Greensboro, Myrtle Beach, and several other locations.

Play with the Professional Staff

All members have numerous opportunities throughout the season to play with a member of our talented professional staff in a fun and relaxing environment.

Discounts on Golf Shop Merchandise and Dining

All members will receive a member's discount of 20% on all items in the golf shop. Items include apparel, shoes, hats, bags, clubs, etc. If members wish to special order an item, they will still receive their member's discount, but are responsible for paying the Shipping/ Handling charges. The member discount may not be used in addition to sales and promotions offered in the golf shop. Additionally, Members receive a dining discount of 15% off Lunch menu items in our restaurant.

Kidz Wild Program

This program has started to gain traction with some good participation. The program allows all Members' children and their accompanied guests to enjoy events held on selected days, activities include Lunch with Santa, the Easter Egg Hunt, Movie Nights and more.

Full Member Family Guest (1up 1down) Policy

A (1up) family guest is the member's father and or mother. A (1down) family guest is a son and or daughter living out of the home. All other family is considered extended family and therefore "guests" (i.e. Aunts, uncles, niece, nephew, etc.)

Golf with the Grandchildren

Grandchildren can play for just a Cart Fee! Accompanied grandchildren of all members who are under the age of 18 will receive a free green fee, and may play for just a cart fee.

Junior Member Golf

Free golf to all junior members under the age of 18-year-old. Pinewild is a leader in the region as it relates to junior golf. This includes the option for all Members under the age of 18 to walk the courses during non-peak times, and at the discretion of the Golf Shop at no charge.

The Member Experience (One Day Member-Guest)

Pinewild would like the members to allow guest to have the member experience of being in the Wild. Full Members will have the opportunity to bring non-member guest for a discounted fee to Pinewild to participate in a fun day of competition followed with fellowship over lunch and prizes. These discounted “Member Experiences” will be held quarterly accommodating all skill levels and gender of golfers.

Pinewild Academy & Golf Instruction

The Pinewild Academy continues to host numerous game-improvement activities to help the Membership improve their golf skills. The Professional Staff is here to help the membership with all aspect of their game. Members may schedule their private, group, or a series of lessons at their convenience. All lessons may be scheduled in person, by phone, and/ or by email with their preferred Professional Staff.

Vendor Fitting Days

Members will have an opportunity each spring to schedule a fitting appointment with their preferred Company. PXG has selected Pinewild as a regional hub to preform fittings, which are exclusively scheduled and facilitated by PXG. If a member would prefer a Private Fitting, they may schedule an appointment with a member of Pinewild Professional Staff at the members convenience.

Tennis & Pickle Ball

The three **Har-Tru Tennis Courts** and four **Har-Tru Pickleball Courts**, which are available to all Members at no charge, consistently remain among some of the best-conditioned in the area, with lighting options available for evening play.

Competition Golf

Boasting the **Holly, Magnolia and Azalea** (9-hole) courses, Pinewild continues to play host to many prestigious USGA, CGA and PGA qualifiers and championships, which are open to Members as volunteers or spectators.

Lake Pinewild

Lake Pinewild, a 25-acre lake, is owned and managed by the Club. This amenity provides great opportunities for fishing, non-motorized boating, or simply just viewing, and lies adjacent to the beach, boat ramp and picnic area which is under the purview of the Property Owners Association.

Clubhouse

The Pinewild Clubhouse plays host to a variety of social opportunities for Members, including a wide-ranging Food and Beverage service, Trivia Nights, special Themed Socials and Dinners, and a wide variety of specialized Member clubs which focus on activities and hobbies other than just golf.

CLUB FACILITIES

The Club Facilities currently provided at Pinewild Country Club of Pinehurst and available for use by Members include the following.

- * An 18-hole par 72 championship golf course commonly known as the “Magnolia Course” and originally designed by Gene Ham.
- * An 18-hole par 72 championship golf course commonly known as the “Holly Course” and originally designed by Gary Player.
- * A 9-hole par 3 course with two sets of tees commonly known as the “Azalea Course.”
- * A 3-hole par 12 academy/practice course commonly known as the “Challenge Course.”
- * Extensive golf practice facilities including a short game practice area, two large putting greens, a chipping area, and practice range.
- * A Clubhouse offering a reception area, dining room, lounge, private dining room known as the Gary Player/Holly Room, and an expansive outdoor patio area overlooking the 18th hole of the Magnolia Course, golf shop, and administrative offices.
- * A swim complex offering a junior Olympic saltwater swimming pool and children’s pool.
- * A tennis/pickleball complex offering three Har-Tru tennis courts and four lighted pickleball courts.

FULL MEMBERSHIP

A Full Membership provides the Member with the non-exclusive use of the Club Facilities in the manner described herein and the opportunity to attend club-sponsored events held at the Club, on a space available basis. Full Members may also host private events and meetings at the Clubhouse on a space available basis upon approval by the Club and payment of applicable fees. Full Members are not charged (i) green fees for use of the Magnolia Course, Holly Course, Azalea Course and Challenge Course, (ii) court fees for use of the tennis and pickleball courts, (iii) pool fees for use of the swimming facilities, or (iv) range fees for use of the golf practice facilities. However, Full Members do pay the applicable fees for use of a golf cart, all service fees, tournament fees, golf handicap fees, other customary fees and charges, personal charges incurred at the Club, and all other Club Fees established by the Club from time to time. Full Members also have the opportunity to participate in club-sponsored golf tournaments on a space available basis upon payment of applicable fees.

CLUB MEMBERSHIP

A Club Membership provides the Member with the non-exclusive use of the Club Facilities in the manner described herein and the opportunity to attend club-sponsored events held at the Club, on a space available basis. Club Members may also host private events and meetings at the Clubhouse on a space available basis upon approval by the Club and payment of applicable fees. Club Members shall pay the applicable green fees established by the Club for use of the Magnolia Course, Holly Course and Azalea Course. Currently, and subject to change in the Club's discretion, a Club Membership allows use of the Magnolia Course and Holly Course a total of five (5) rounds per quarter per Membership upon payment of a reduced green fee; and all additional golf rounds during the quarter shall be at a higher green fee established by the Club. Club Members are not charged (i) green fees for use of the Challenge Course, (ii) court fees for use of the tennis and pickleball courts, or (iii) pool fees for use of the swimming facilities. However, Club Members do pay the applicable fees for use of a golf cart and the golf practice facilities, all service fees, tournament fees, golf handicap fees, other customary fees and charges, personal charges incurred at the Club, and all other Club Fees established by the Club from time to time. The fees charged to Club Members for use of the Magnolia Course, Holly Course and Azalea Course shall be less than the fees charged to Leisure Members. Club Members also have the opportunity to participate in club-sponsored golf tournaments on a space available basis upon payment of applicable fees.

LIFESTYLE MEMBERSHIP

Lifestyle Members may also host private events and meetings at the Clubhouse on a space available basis upon approval by the Club and payment of applicable fees. Lifestyle Members are not charged (i) court fees for use of the tennis and pickleball courts or (ii) pool fees for use of the swimming facilities. However, Lifestyle Members do pay all service fees, other customary fees and charges, personal charges incurred at the Club, and all other Club Fees established by the Club from time to time. Lifestyle Members only have access to the Magnolia Course, Holly Course, Azalea Course and Challenge Course as a guest of another Member in accordance with the Club's guest policy and payment of applicable guest fees. Lifestyle Members may only use the golf practice facilities immediately prior to playing the Magnolia Course, Holly Course, Azalea Course or Challenge Course as a guest of another Member.

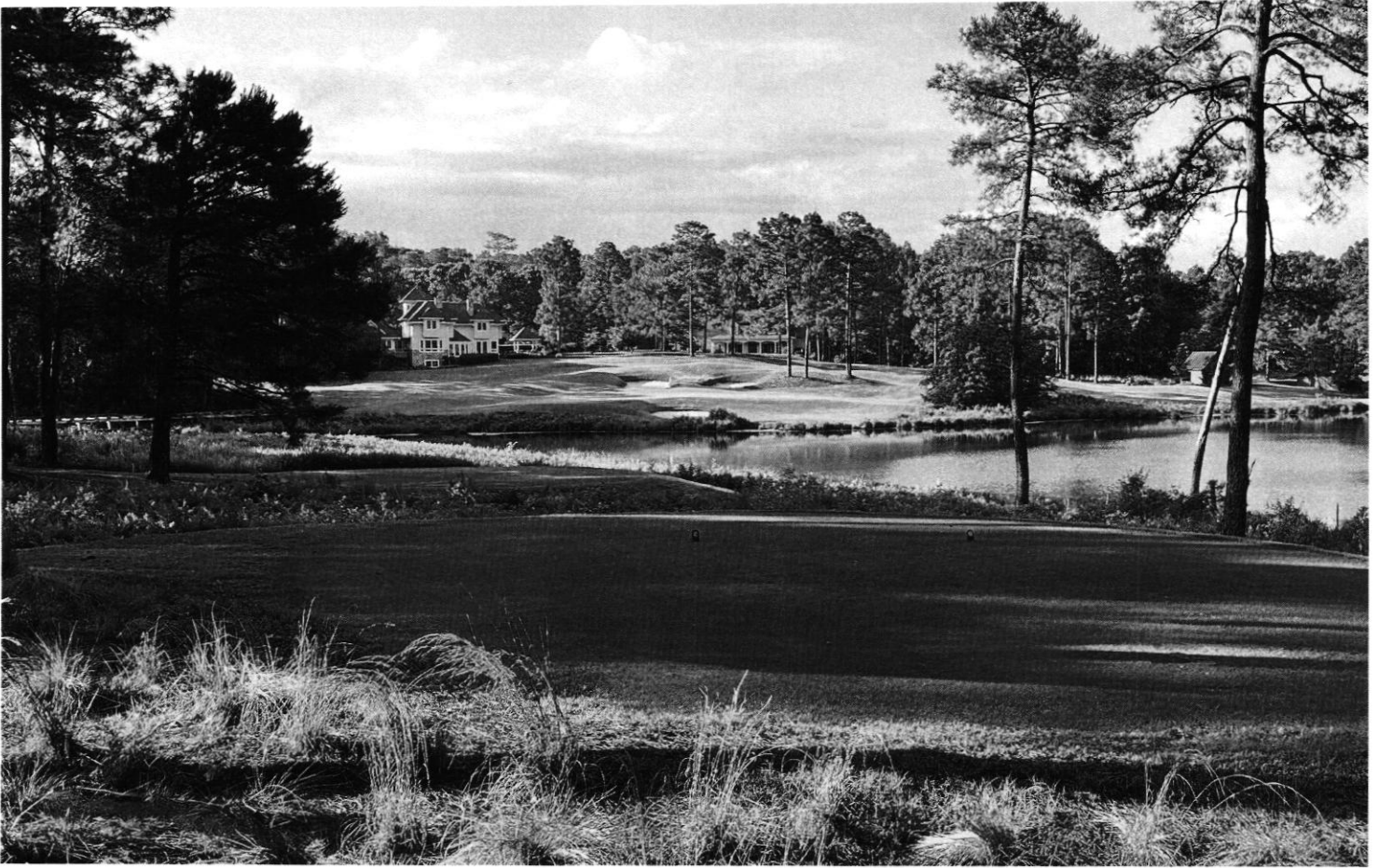


THE MAGNOLIA

A true Sandhills gem, Magnolia could be described as Pinewild's stalwart son. Originally designed by Gene Hamm, the 18-Hole, par 72 Magnolia Course is characterized by vast elevation changes, generous driving areas, traditional Sandhills bunkers, and spacious challenging greens.

With the back tees measuring almost 7,400 yards and its traditional design, the Magnolia is chosen year after year by the USGA, CGA, and PGA for qualifier rounds. That speaks to the quality of the design as well as its continued appeal. It also serves as an opportunity for members to observe these tournaments as volunteers and spectators. One thing is certain, once a golfer has played Magnolia, they never forget it.

THE HOLLY

If the Magnolia is Pinewild's stalwart son, the Holly is its impish twin brother. A special signature design by golf's legendary world traveler, Gary Player, The Holly features smaller green surfaces, less bunkering, and numerous water features that are an integral element of the design. Vast areas of longleaf pines were left untouched, and the course features a more natural setting and rustic feel.

While it's a shorter course than Magnolia at 6,923 yards, the Holly is a shot-makers course to be certain. A fun ride from the first tee, Player challenges you with risk/reward shots and has used every possible feature in the existing landscape to make this course memorable.

THE AZALEA

The Azalea is the other courses' playful little cousin, mirroring the Magnolia's aesthetic and routing. It plays to a nine-hole par 27, but two sets of tees, ranging from 97 to 192 yards, means that you'll use almost every iron in your bag.

The Azalea — one of the earliest 9-hole courses to be rated after the minimum length requirement was dropped in 2023 — has a 27.5 course rating and 85 slope rating for men and a 28.5/86 for women. Much to the delight to our Azalea member leagues, that means you can post your scores after a quick 9 holes.

Of course, Azalea is also a great course to work on your short game or to spend the afternoon with your children. Play only takes around 60 minutes, but in that time, you will experience one of the greatest collections of par-3 holes imaginable.

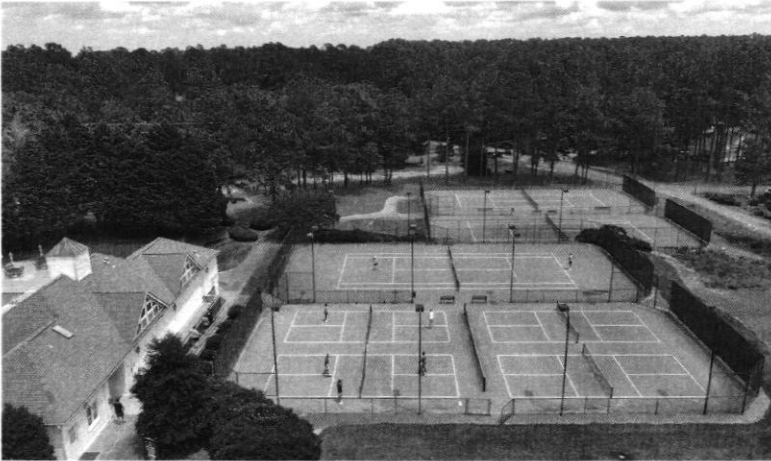
CHALLENGE COURSE & PRACTICE FACILITIES

LAKE PINEWILD

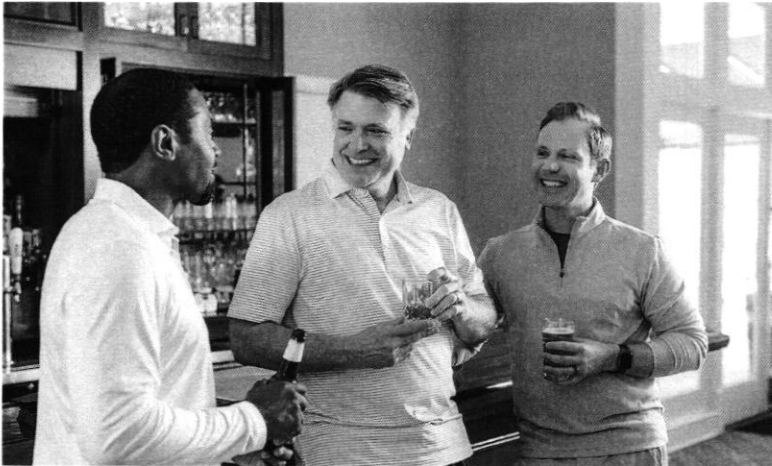
The 25-acre Lake Pinewild is relaxing spot for a kayak or canoe outing, offering fountain features and scenic views of the property.

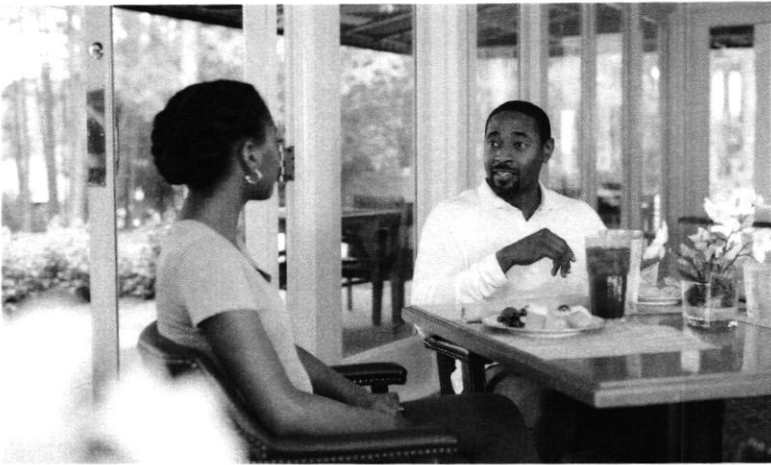
