

Tarin Woods Pool Rules

The following rules are for the pool area, which includes, but is not limited to, the pool water, concrete area surrounding the pool, and landscaped area surrounding the pool. Violations of these rules could result in loss of pool privileges following a POA hearing.

1. Swim at your own risk, there is no lifeguard on duty.
2. Shower before entering the pool.
3. The Association is not responsible for the loss, theft of, or damage to any personal property.
4. The pool is for the use of Tarin Woods Owners Association members only and their guests (with member present). Each member shall have with them the proper identification (access card) or will be asked to leave.
5. Abusive language, intoxication, boisterous conduct or vandalism will not be tolerated.
6. No loud playing of radios or other sound amplification equipment.
7. Proper swimming attire must be worn in the pool at all times. No cut-off jeans, disposable diapers, cloth or training pants containing plastic, or any other filter clogging clothing is allowed in the pool.
8. No diving shall be permitted.
9. No glass objects shall be permitted in the pool area.
10. No pushing, shoving, or running shall be allowed anywhere in the pool area.
11. No pets shall be allowed in the pool area.
12. Consider other swimmers when using pool toys.
13. No personal canopies, tents, or umbrellas are allowed in the pool area.
14. The pool gate should remain in the closed position before and after entry. Do not prop it open for any reason.
15. Cooking grills of any kind are not allowed in the pool area.
16. Clean up after yourself, family, and guests.
17. No reservations will be taken for private pool parties. There are a limited number of tables and umbrellas available, so members should only use tables when actively swimming.
18. No skateboards, roller blades, bicycles, tricycles, etc. are allowed in the pool area.
