The Club

Pinehurst Country Club features 9 golf courses, The Cradle short course, tennis, pickleball, croquet, lawn bowls, fitness centers, Member pool complex, beach club at Lake Pinehurst, private Member restaurant, and a full calendar of social events.

Membership Qualifications

The Club offers transferable and non-transferable memberships.

Transferable – memberships are attached to properties within the Village of Pinehurst. New buyers will have 60 days from closing to submit a membership application and shall pay a reduced initiation fee to transfer.

Charter – A new property owner may apply a 50% discount to the prevailing initiation fee of the category selected.

Non - Transferable – memberships are available to property owners within a 60 mile radius of the Club. Non-transferable memberships shall pay the full prevailing initiation fee.

Applying for Membership

Member candidates must complete an application and pay the transfer or initiation fee upon submission of application. Applications will be evaluated on the basis of interest of the applicant in the use of the Club facilities; compatibility with Club Members and the purposes of the Club; demonstrated desire to enhance the Club experience for all Members.

Applications will be evaluated on the above criteria without regard to age (18 and over), race, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, veteran status, disability, or religion.

Classes of Membership

Membership categories: **Signature Golf** | **Premier Golf** | **Sports** | **Social**

Membership privileges are extended to the primary Member, spouse or significant other designee and all dependent children under the age of 23.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Is the Club currently enrolling new Members?

A. Yes! Pinehurst is enrolling new Members in the Social and Sports categories. There are wait lists for the Golf membership categories. If a Golf category is desired, a new Member may enroll in the Sports category and wait for a space to become available. Wait list times are estimated based on attrition trends and are not guaranteed.

Q. What are the costs associated with enrolling at the Club?

A. An initiation or transfer fee is required to accompany a membership application to obtain membership privileges. There are also monthly dues and fees associated with a membership. No food & beverage minimums or assessments.

Q. What if I purchase a property in No. 7 or No. 9?

A. PCC offers three (3) membership categories to property owners within the 7/9 neighborhoods: Signature Golf, Signature Sport, and Signature Social. Residents of the No. 7/9 communities are not required to go onto a wait list. **See Signature Membership grid for details*

Q. May I join Signature Golf if I do not live in either community?

A. Yes, you may apply for the Signature Golf category by satisfying the Premier Golf level and going onto a wait list. Some access to No. 7 and No. 9 is granted while on the Signature Golf wait list.

Q. Can I reestablish a new transferable membership on a property where one was dissolved or never existed?

A. Yes, a new transferable Charter membership can be established on a property within the Village of Pinehurst by satisfying at minimum a \$45,000 initiation fee. If the property is in No. 7 or No. 9 the fee to establish a new transferable Charter membership is \$65,000. This allows the Member to enjoy the lower Charter monthly dues, and adds attractiveness to the property for future resale.

Q. Can I move my transferable membership to another property?

A. Yes, as long as the property is in the Village of Pinehurst. If the new property has an existing transferable membership, you may swap the two memberships at no cost. A Relocation Request must be submitted within 10 days of purchase and the original property must be sold within 18 months. If the new property does not have a transferable membership, Members may execute a split to create a transferable membership on the new property so they may relocate their transferable membership. In either case, a transferable membership must remain on the original property.

Q. Can I upgrade my membership category?

A. Yes, you can upgrade your membership category by submitting a change of status form. You will apply the original initiation/transfer fee paid and pay the balance of the higher categories initiation/transfer fee.

Q. How often can I change my membership status?

A. A change to a membership status must be maintained for a minimum of 12 months. The Club will approve one (1) medical exemption to upgrade within the 12 month window per lifetime of a membership.

Q. What is the guest policy?

A. With the exception of unaccompanied golf tee times, Members are required to accompany guests when using Club amenities. Guests are permitted to enjoy all of the social and recreational facilities when accompanied by their Member host. Members shall register their accompanied guests when checking in at the recreational facility being used. Various guest fees apply. Any guest residing within a 60-mile radius of the Club is limited to two visits per month.

Q. How are tee times allocated for Members and Resort Guests?

A. Each day there is 50% split aggregate on courses No. 1-6 and typically Member allocation will run around 65% for the year. These percentages are based only on 18-hole playable tee times.

When building our tee sheets for the year, we begin with our contracted Resort groups and then all of our Member tournaments are added to the calendar. Once these two items are complete, we begin to allocate the sheets as Member and Resort. Once the split is completed, we then release the tee sheets to our reservations department to start booking our leisure Resort guests.

Member guest tee times are placed into the system 30 days out. For example, on May 15th, the Member guest tee times are placed into the system for June 15th. Then roughly 11-14 days out, some of the unused Resort times are then switched to Member-allocated and placed into the booking website. Then 24 hours out, all of our unused resort tee times are released back to the membership for booking. We monitor these tee sheets daily to fully maximize availability for the membership.



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
