

POOL USAGE AND RULES

The use of the Brunswick House Pool and the Activity Center Pool is restricted to members in good standing and their families/guests. Pool rules include but are not limited to the following:

Who May Use the Pool

1. All POA Members in Good Standing their families and guests.
2. Renters with a lease term of less than one (1) year may only use the following amenities on weekdays during the months of June, July, and August: The Brunswick House, the Hampton Amenity Center (to be built), Tennis and Pickle Ball Courts, and all pools including the Brunswick House outdoor & indoor pools and the Amenity Center pool located in the Hamptons-themed neighborhood.
3. Anyone under the age of 16 or any non-swimmers must be accompanied by an adult (age 21 or older).
4. Any child under the age of 14 is not allowed in the hot tub.

Health and Safety

1. Infants and toddlers must wear approved disposable swim wear when using the pools.
2. Any adult with incontinence problems must also conform to the use of approved disposable swim wear.
3. No person with a skin, eye or nasal infection or communicable disease is allowed in the pool.
4. It is recommended that everyone showers before entering the pools.
5. No animals or pets are allowed in the pool area.
6. It is strongly recommended that no one swims alone.
7. It is strongly recommended that no one under the influence of alcohol swims in the pool.
8. Management reserves the right to close the pool for any reason.

Pool Area Behavior

Parents/adult supervisors are expected to enforce the following rules:

1. Wrestling, pushing, running, dunking, rough play, throwing of hard toys or balls, or general horseplay will not be permitted in the pool or enclosed area. Participation in such activity may result in being asked to leave the pool facility.
2. There is *No Smoking or Vaping* anywhere at the Brunswick House or the Activity Center pool.
3. *Food and drinks may not be consumed while in the pool.* Only drinks in non-breakable containers are allowed on the pool decks.
4. The pool water is shallow. No diving is allowed in any section of the pool.
5. Footwear should be limited to soft soles or flip flops.
6. No pets are allowed in any of the POA Facilities except those trained to assist persons with disabilities.
7. The pool and surrounding facilities are for the enjoyment of all the members, their guests and families. Inappropriate or offensive behavior or abusive language will not be tolerated. In such a case, the offending person or persons will be asked to leave.
8. The handicapped chair lift is not a toy and is to be used by people requiring assistance getting in and out of the pool only.
9. Lap swimming is encouraged but not limited to 6 AM to 9 AM and 5 PM to 7 PM daily, while the pool is less crowded.
10. Loud or offensive music is prohibited.
11. At the sound of thunder, all swimmers and sunbathers should leave the pool area. A thunderstorm is considered "as ended" when there has been no sound of thunder within the last 15 minutes of clearing. An additional 5-15 minutes of safety margin is recommended

The Community Manager, ASC Coordinator, Brunswick Plantation Amenities Committee Members and Board of Directors have the authority to enforce the rules. Failure of a member or guest to abide by these rules can lead to removal from the pool and/or suspension of privileges.
