

RELEASE DEED

JAMES E. BARKHOUSE, JOHNA H. BARKHOUSE and MARGUERITE M. HAMBLÉN, of Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, for consideration paid, **RELEASES** to **JAMES E. BARKHOUSE and JOHNA A. BARKHOUSE**, of Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, the land together with the buildings thereon situated in Ellsworth, County of Hancock, State of Maine, to wit:

Three certain lots or parcels of land together with the buildings thereon situated in Ellsworth, County of Hancock, State of Maine, being bounded and described as follows, to wit:

"FIRST LOT: Beginning at a stake and stone on the southerly side of Laurel Street and close to the western side of a large rock at a point fifteen rods and two feet from the corner of the intersection of the south line of Laurel Street and the west line of Maple Street; thence from said stake and stone southerly at right angles to Laurel Street ten rods to the back line; thence westerly on said back line four rods; thence northerly at right angles to Laurel Street ten rods to a stake and stones in the south line of Laurel Street; thence Easterly on the south line of the last mentioned street four rods to place of beginning; containing forty square rods.

"SECOND LOT: Beginning at an iron bolt at the northeast corner of the lat Michael Coughlin's homestead lot in the south line of Laurel Street; thence easterly in said south line of said Laurel Street fifteen feet to a stone post marked with a cross; thence south thirteen and one-half degrees west following the fence as now built ten rods to another post marked with a cross in the Black line; thence westerly in said black line eighteen feet, more or less, to an iron bolt at said Coughlin's Southeast corner; thence northeasterly in said Coughlin's east line to place of beginning, containing ten rods, more or less.

"THIRD LOT: Beginning in the south line of Laurel Street and the east line of the Black lot so-called; thence easterly in said south line of said Laurel Street about five rods to a stake at the Northwest corner of land now or formerly of Alfred Joy; thence southerly at right angles to said south line of said Laurel Street and in said Joy's west line ten rods to the Black line; thence westerly in said Black line about four rods to said east line of said Black lot; thence in said east line of said Black lot about ten rods to the place of beginning, containing forty-five square rods, more or less, and being lot marked number 13 and a strip from the west side of lot marked number 14 on a plan of lots formerly owned by Calvin G. Peck, made by L. B. Wyman."

Being the same premises as described in the deed from Mary Ann Harriman to James E. Barkhouse, Johna H. Barkhouse and Marguerite M. Hamblen dated November 2, 1995 and recorded in Book 2456 Page 272, Hancock County Registry of Deeds.
