The deeds of conveyance of lots B & C will contain substantially the following language: The Grantees agree, for themselves, their heirs and assigns, to the following restrictive covenants (not conditions subsequent):

1. No existing culverts will be closed, and the entrances or outlets of said culverts will be kept clear.
2. This restriction shall be for the benefit of all lands shown on this survey and for the further benefit of the Inhabitants of the Municipality of Surry and the State of Maine.
3. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the closing of said culverts or the partial blocking of the entrances or outlets of said culverts with the consent of the owners of other lands shown on this survey and the consent of the Surry Planning Board, and (if required by law) the consent of the State of Maine.
